There will be classes on how to play traditional native games such as bean wars and stickball as well as classes on native dance styles which can be used at the pow-wow where everyone will be able to showcase their dancing abilities. Cub Scouts will eat lunch in the dining hall and join us for a real Native American feast for dinner, all as part of the fee. We guarantee a day of Native American culture with classes, games, food, dancing, singing, fun and even a free patch for attending. Bring only a mind for learning and a camp chair for the pow-wow and you'll be able to leave with: native crafts, items from our traditional vendors and most importantly memories to last a lifetime.
