

Unit Assessment

You will have **12 minutes to complete steps 1-4.**

1. As a group you will assess the unit assigned to you. **Look at the Program logo (Pack ,Troop or Crew) on the outside of the envelope to determine which scenario you will complete.** In your packet you will find copies of a unit scenario, one copy for each person in the group (same scenario).
2. Read through the scenario and discuss what this unit needs to be successful and how a commissioner can help them.
3. Complete a simple, overall evaluation on a scale of 1 – 5. Identify at least two factors resulting in your evaluation.
4. Complete a detailed evaluation (on a scale of 1 – 5) of Finance, Membership, Program, and Leadership. Identify at least one specific strength or opportunity in each category. For each opportunity, identify a specific action that would strengthen the unit and assign responsibility (i.e., “committee member Jones,” “assistant scoutmaster Smith,” “COR Anderson,” “district committee training committee,” etc., and set a target date for completion. Use the scoring matrix which is also included; note the wording change for the Program Plan.
5. Be prepared for one person in your group to report out what you see as the priority needs (could be one or several, pick one to report out) of the unit and what action you will take to help them succeed.
